Ford Continues Public Discussion on ‘Conceal and Carry’ with Additional Public Hearing

CHICAGO, IL – Due to a strong level of interest and participation in his first public meeting on conceal and carry, state Rep. La Shawn K. Ford (D-Chicago) is hosting a second public town hall meeting and debate on whether the state of Illinois should allow eligible residents to obtain a permit to carry a concealed firearm.

“Our first hearing on conceal and carry was very productive, and drew a lot of residents and a variety of viewpoints from crime victims to 2nd Amendment supporters,” Ford said. “I want residents to know that I am still keeping an open mind on this issue, and that it is important to hear from those I represent so that I can make the best decision for the people.”
